READ 1 THESSALONIANS 5:23 & 24

Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it.

Why do you think Paul prays/says this at the very end of his letter?

Paul makes it clear that we have got to be growing and becoming more like Jesus. It is not an option to stay as we are.
